On February 12, 2002, the Board of Education approved a negotiated fee with Kovacs, Whitney, and Associatestoprovide consultants services for the systemic renovations of Dundalk Middle School. These services included the preparation of construction documents and assisting with the bidding phase of this project, which incl ude the replacement of the existing boilers. Due to the condition of the existing boilers, their replacement has been bid as a separate contract. This will allow the boilers to be installed without delay while the design for the remainder of the project is completed.

The Department of Physical Facilities has negotiated a fee with Kovacs, Whitney, and Associates to provide construction administration services for the boiler replacement projects. These services will consist of the review and approval of project submittals, attendance at pre construction and bi -weeklyprogress meetings, conducting site visits, review of payment requests and change order requests, addressing questions raised by the contractor and BCPS during the course of construction, prep aration of punch list, verification of completion, and providing substantial completion documentation.

At this time, we request the Board's approval of the negotiated fee in the amount of \$8,105.60 for Kovacs, Whitney, and Associates to provide construction administration services for the boiler replacement project at Dundalk Middle School.

Funding for these services is available through Capital Budget Project #665 – Major Maintenance.
