Digital Resources for Knowledge Workers Executive Summary


With the exponential growth of information and the democratization of information production (blogs, tweets, wikis, YouTube, etc.), there is an increasing need for information consumers and knowledge workers to apply critical thinking and evaluative skills in the selection of information for decision making and research. According to a 2003 UC Berkeley study, the global production in 2002 was five exabytes of information and this number is growing by roughly 30 per cent every year, which means the total amount of stored information almost doubles every three years. In other words, an exabyte is approximately 500,000 times the amount of data in the print collection of the Library of Congress. To further illustrate the impact of this exponential growth of information, a Google search of the concept "school reform" yielded 1.6 million search results! Sifting through this maze of information to find that "golden nugget" of information among the "landfills" is neither an effective use of time nor a strategic information seeking skill. A potential solution for coping with information overload and access to quality information is the emergence of digital libraries focused on content for specific audiences.

Baltimore County Public Schools provides 24/7 online access to outstanding licensed digital content to support the information and research needs of educators and stakeholders. Specifically, these authoritative resources include, but are not limited to, *ProQuest Education Journals* and the *Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development Professional (ASCD) Education Collection*. Following are overviews of these resources:

- **ProQuest Education** gives users access to over 790 top educational publications, including more than 615 of the titles in full text. Offering complete information on hundreds of educational topics, this database offers complete text and images to include all the charts, tables, diagrams, and other graphical elements often used to enhance the editorial value of articles that focus on education topics. Articles selected by the user may be translated into eleven languages. The interface offers users an intuitive search platform with powerful tools to target and find information by keyword, Boolean logic, topic, or publication. In addition, users may set up an Alert and/or RSS Feed to stay informed on a research topic. Search alerts are sent to the user's email for new content added based on the user's previous search query.
- *The ASCD Education Collection* features 95 electronic books spanning a wide range of popular titles that addresses the ongoing needs of today's educators. A powerful search interface enables a simultaneous, multi-searching of all 95 e-books. Articles and chapters within each e-book may be downloaded, printed, or emailed.

These resources are accessible 24/7 from the Office of Library Information Services homepage at <u>http://www.bcps.org/offices/lis</u>. No password is needed when accessing these resources within the BCPS network. Passwords are required for remote access.
