McMillion, Mr. John H. Offerman, Jr., Ms. Cheryl E. Pasteur, Ms. Lily P. Rowe, Ms. Makeda Scott, and Student Member Omer Reshid.

Mr. Nussbaum provided legal advice concerning state and federal waivers pertaining to COVID-19; waivers/changes to Board policy related to COVID-19 closures; and a proposed resolution related to Board policy waivers.

Prior to the commencement of the administrative function session, all staff members left the call, with the exception of Dr. Williams, Ms. Howie, and Mr. Dickerson.
