BCPS announces spring sports season expectations for attending athletic games

Towson, MD – Baltimore County Public Schools will continue to allow spectators at athletic games for the spring season beginning Friday, May 7.

BCPS will continue to provide opportunities for three spectators per athlete per game. At some smaller facilities, adjustments may be made to accommodate spectators safely, under current social distancing guidelines.

Masks and social distancing for spectators, coaches, and officials will continue to be required. Student athletes may remove their masks when competing or conditioning in practice. Student athletes must wear their masks at all other times.

School system leaders appreciate the support the Baltimore County community provides for the safe implementation of athletic programs at county schools.

Tickets are \$5 each (plus a service fee), paperless, and are needed for entrance to permitted athletic events.
