Rising Grade 8 students invited to participate in free Career and Technical Education Virtual Summer Camp

Weeklong half-day camp will introduce students to CTE program, related careers

Towson, MD – Rising Grade 8 Baltimore County Public Schools students are invited to participate in a free, weeklong [Career and Technical Education](#) (CTE) Virtual Summer Camp.

“This is an exciting new summer learning opportunity for our students, and I appreciate the work of CTE staff in developing this camp,” said BCPS Superintendent Dr. Darryl L. Williams. “I encourage families to register their children early to secure a seat.”

The camp will feature hands-on activities, virtual field trips, and guest speakers, and all sessions will be led by BCPS educators. Through camp activities, students will be introduced to CTE programs related to the following career clusters:

- Arts, Media, and Communication
- Business, Management, and Finance
- Consumer Services, Hospitality, and Tourism
- Construction and Development
- Environmental, Agricultural, and Natural Resource Systems
- Health and Biosciences
- Human Resource Services
- Information Technology
- Manufacturing, Engineering, and Technology
- Transportation Technologies

The camp will take place Monday, June 28, through Friday, July 2. Students will participate in either a morning group (9 a.m. – 12:15 p.m.) or afternoon group (11:45 a.m. – 3 p.m.). There are no fees associated with the program, and the first 200 applicants will be accepted. Registered students will receive a CTE bag filled with camp supplies and promotional items.
