2022 BCPS Stakeholder Climate Survey to begin Monday, Jan. 31

Students, parents/caregivers, staff, community members invited to share their views

TOWSON, MD. -- Baltimore County Public Schools invites students in Grades 3-12, parents/caregivers, staff, and community members to participate in the school system's annual Stakeholder Climate Survey beginning Monday, January 31.

The brief online survey will be available on the <u>BCPS home page</u> from January 31 through Friday, March 4, 2022. The survey is again available in multiple languages for students, parents, and community members.

"This annual survey is an important way for us to listen to the BCPS community, learn their views, and to be responsive to their feedback by taking action to improve our schools and school system," said BCPS Superintendent Dr. Darryl L. Williams, adding that survey feedback is used by schools to refine School Progress Plans as well as by BCPS to measure progress toward goals in The Compass strategic plan.
