Additional community forum scheduled to review options for improving southeast Baltimore County high schools

Public invited to attend March 16 meeting either in person or online

What: Baltimore County Public Schools has scheduled an additional community forum for the public to review options and solicit feedback on how best to improve buildings, enhance school use, and provide capacity relief for high schools in the county's southeast area. The public will be able to attend the new forum either in person or online; the first virtual meeting for the southeast area took place on March 2, while a third southeast meeting is scheduled for 6:30 p.m. on Thursday, April 21, 2022. In the event of inclement weather, an alternate date will be announced.

Schools under study in the southeast area are Dundalk, Patapsco, and Sparrows Point high schools.
