## **“Art is for Everyone” exhibition extended through March 27 at the Baltimore Museum of Art**

***See student artwork hanging in the galleries of one of Baltimore’s  
premier museums***

**What:** The “Art is for Everyone” exhibition of student artwork at the Baltimore Museum of Art has been extended through Sunday, March 27. The exhibition features more than 260 artworks from 120 schools, including drawings, sculptures, mixed media, photography, digital art, paintings, and collaborative creations from Baltimore County Public Schools’ students in PreKindergarten through Grade 12. Please note that the Baltimore Museum of Art encourages visitors to wear masks, and [timed tickets](#) are required for any visit. Admission to the museum is free, but it is not guaranteed without a pass.

**When:** **Exhibition:** through Sunday, March 27, 2022. Museum hours are 10 a.m. – 5 p.m. on Wednesday, Friday, Saturday. and Sunday and 10 a.m. – 9 p.m. on Thursday. (The museum is closed on Monday and Tuesday.)

**Meet and Greet for participants and their families:** Sunday, March 27, 2022, from 1 – 4 p.m. At this event, students with art in the exhibition will receive certificates, stickers, and art kits.

**Where:** The Baltimore Museum of Art, 10 Art Museum Drive, Baltimore 21218  
(Street parking is available around the museum as well as paid parking on the BMA grounds.)

**Background:** The exhibition originally was scheduled from March 16-20 with a Meet and Greet for participants and their families on Sunday, March 20. On March 20, however, the museum experienced a power outage and had to temporarily close for a few hours. Because of this closure and the popularity of this exhibit, the museum extended the exhibition.

Students who do not receive their certificates during Meet and Greet hours will receive them at school from their art teachers.
