Upcoming community forum to review options for improving high schools in southeastern Baltimore County

Public invited to attend April 21 meeting either in person or online

A community forum on the future of high schools in southeastern Baltimore County will be held both virtually and in person at Patapsco High School and Center for the Arts. Previously, the meeting was to be virtual only. The forum, which invites the public to review options and provide feedback on improving buildings, enhancing school use, and providing capacity relief for southeast high schools, is the third such forum this winter and spring.
