Board of Education of Baltimore County to meet on Tuesday, August 9, 2022

Towson, MD – The Board of Education will hold its next meeting on Tuesday, August 9, 2022, at its Greenwood Campus, 6901 N. Charles Street, Building E, Towson, Maryland 21204.

The Board’s regular open session will begin in person at approximately 5 p.m. The Board will then meet in closed session as permitted by law. The open session will reconvene at 6:30 p.m.

Public comment and attendance will take place in person at the meeting, with limited capacity. Registration for stakeholder and general public comment will continue to be through the [online registration form](#), and only those preregistered stakeholder groups and selected general public comment speakers will be allowed access to the building. In addition, members of the public who want to [attend only](#) to view the Board meeting in person will register online in advance and be randomly selected (based on capacity).
