January 25 meeting of the Central Area Elementary School Capacity Relief Boundary Study Committee is cancelled

Recommendation scheduled to go to the Board of Education on Feb. 27

Towson, MD – Because the Central Area Elementary School Capacity Relief Boundary Study Committee has reached a recommendation, its final scheduled meeting, slated for Thursday, January 25, is no longer needed and has been cancelled.

The committee studying boundary options for central area elementary schools will present its recommendation to the Board of Education of Baltimore County on Tuesday, February 27, 2024.

The committee had been charged with providing recommendations to relieve schools projected to be overcrowded and to maximize the use of available space at elementary schools in the region. The study scope included 19 schools. More information about the study and committee meetings may be found at the [boundary study website](#).

To reach a recommendation, the committee considered all information and feedback gained through four committee meetings, two public information sessions, and an online survey. Following the committee's Feb. 27 presentation, the Board will hold a public hearing scheduled for Wednesday, March 6, 2024, at Loch Raven High School, before deciding on the new boundary lines by Tuesday, March 19, 2024.
